This distribution of the poem is not a copyright infringement because the group has paid for the use of the poem. Please pay special attention to copyrights when making Agape. All Agape brought to future Walks will be carefully monitored for Copyright issues and any Agape that appears to be in violation of this law will be returned to the Reunion Group without being distributed to the Pilgrims.
