#### A Praying Sponsor – a God Inspired Pilgrim

The Lansing Area Emmaus Community welcomed me at Walk #55 in March of 2003 at Christ United Methodist Church in Lansing MI.

I never envisioned I would be writing you, or serving in the leadership roles in my church or this community. God works in mysterious ways and he equips the called.

The Walk to Emmaus changed my life. I'm better than I was, but I'm far from finished.

I pray that God will be honored through my action in my church, this community and my 4<sup>th</sup> day. I also try to be open and flexible, allowing God to continue to mold me.

Our 4<sup>th</sup> day is made up of many parts: prayer, scripture reading, worship, our jobs, service in our church and our communities, board meetings, team training, agape, Gatherings, reunion groups, Walks, candle light service, sponsorship etc...

Our teams are forming for the upcoming Fall Walks, training has begun and many, many people will be called to serve both in the conference rooms and behind the scenes. We need servants, sponsors, Pilgrims and prayer, lots and lots of prayer.

If you are called to serve please return the call, the person making that request has many people to contact. We want you to serve but we also realize you may not be able to at this time.

There are openings for Men's and Women's Pilgrims for the fall walks. Sponsorship is a great way to serve.

When you sponsor an individual you become God's instrument and you take on the responsibility for that specific Pilgrim.

What does a Sponsor actually do? Need a short refresher, here are some Sponsorship Tips from *Emmaus of the Albemarle, Inc July 2012 Newsletter:* 

1. Pray for the person's openness to God's call to Discipleship, not for how to get them on a walk.

2. Make an appointment to visit with the person or couple to discuss the possibility of them attending a walk.

3. Extend an invitation. Invite them to attend a weekend for a more vital relationship with Jesus Christ . . . not just a weekend retreat or getaway.

4. Share YOUR faith and explain the basic elements of the walk . . . its purpose and how it

helps us live in a life of grace for the rest of our lives.

5. Have the attitude that you are giving them a wonderful gift rather than that they need to go.

6. Ask them to make a commitment by filling out the application form. If the person is married, speak with both partners and encourage an equal commitment by both spouses.

7. Continue to pray . . . and when they agree to go, review the application and make sure it is complete before sending it in.

8. When they are accepted for a weekend prepare agape letters and enlist support of their pastor and family to collect personal agape letters.

9. A few days before their Walk weekend remind your pilgrim about the upcoming Walk. Offer guidance about what to pack for the weekend. Guidelines are in the letters sent to each pilgrim.

10. Support the walk through participation on the 72-Hour Prayer Vigil.

11. Make sure they get to the weekend, introducing him or her to others.

12. Attend Sponsor's Hour, which follows send-off, and pray for your pilgrim.

13. If the person you sponsor has special needs, make sure they are taken care of.

14. Support the Pilgrim's family. If needed feed pets and water plants.

15. Attend the Gathering and Candlelight during the weekend.

16. Continue to pray.

17. Attend Closing and then help your Pilgrim reenter.

18. Assist your pilgrim with participation in a Reunion/Accountability Group, or help start one if needed.

19. Encourage them to explore how they can be better servants to their church.

20. Explain how they can serve the community by sponsoring and being a team member on a walk weekend.

21. Take your Pilgrim to their first Reunion group and Gathering.

22. Teach the new Emmaus member how to be a good sponsor and be sure he/she understands the responsibilities of good sponsorship, by your actions.

23. Continue to pray.

Please pray for the teams and pilgrims of the upcoming walks and that God will provide the pilgrims He calls to have a deeper relationship with Him!



### SO YOU'RE THINKING ABOUT SPONSORING

Sponsoring a pilgrim is very rewarding. Your pilgrim will be blessed but you will be also. Here are a few things you can do to make my job easier:

Please print legibly and encourage your pilgrim to print neatly also.

Please know your pilgrim's health needs. Do they need a cot, are they allergic to anything, do they have a hard time with getting around. We want to do the best we can to make the pilgrims comfortable and the more we know the better.

Please check the LAEC website lansingemmaus.truepath.com and make sure that I have the spelling of your pilgrim's name correct. There is nothing worse than a pilgrim arriving to registration the night of the walk and for me to find out I have spelled their name wrong. Also check that I have their church and your name listed correctly. I am human and I also make mistakes.

Please let me know if there is any chance of a pilgrim having a close relation with another pilgrim. Best friends, relatives, childhood friends, etc. We want the pilgrims to be able to share openly at their tables and they may not be able to if their Aunt or Niece is at their table.

Please get your application in early. Remember for every person that needs to handle that application it will add a few days. The pilgrim filling it out, you filling out your part and then getting the pastor signature and then through the US postal mail. I am expecting the fall walks to fill up very quickly. We already have 22 women and 11 men signed up. So get to working on them now!

The falls walks will be held at Trinity UMC, 7533 W. St. Joe Hwy, Lansing, MI and the men's walk will be October 4 - 7, 2012 and the women's October 18 - 21, 2012.
