

Will You Join in the Thanksgiving?

On your feet now—applaud GoD! Bring a gift of laughter, sing yourselves into his presence. Know this: GoD is God, is GoD. He made us; we didn't make him. We're his people, his well-tended sheep. Enter with the password: "Thank you!" Make yourselves at home, talking praise. Thank him. Worship him. For GoD is sheer beauty, all-generous in love, loyal always and ever." (Psalm 100 – The Message Paraphrase)

I love The Message paraphrase. For me, it comes across with just a bit of realism that brings new life to some passages I have learned differently over the years...this one especially.

For my brain, Psalm 100 has always started "Make a joyful noise to the Lord all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come into his presence with singing." Now does it sound more familiar?

Maybe that's the problem? This whole "thanks to God" thing has become so familiar that it sounds almost foreign to us when we're commanded to get on our feet and applaud our God. Could we even do it? Try this, stand to your feet and for the next minute, just sixty seconds, I invite you to give God some applause. Go ahead...yes you....God is waiting and I'll wait too.

How odd was that? I started running out of steam at thirty seconds! But I kept going anyway, and I hope that you did too or that at least you'll keep trying. Doesn't our God who is all generous in love and always loyal deserve that praise and more?

These times are not times for just simply telling one another what we're thankful for, even though that can be rewarding. These times require something more. God is God is God is God and our God is asking us to thank him, to make ourselves at home with him, to share our praise with him, and to worship him. He made us...we didn't make him! We are his and by his grace, he is ours, so are we truly willing to show it?
