My name is Michelle Lautner. I took walk #73 the Lansing Area Emmaus Community in March 2009 at Trinity UMC in Lansing where I sat at the table of Rebekah. I am currently serving as the board chair for Leadership Development.

I just have a few things to share with you. First, please don't forget that in order to sponsor pilgrims, you do need to make sure that you have had sponsorship training within the last 2 years. Training is held at each monthly gathering as well as at the Saturday night candlelight at each walk, so there are plenty of opportunities for you to attend training. It's pretty painless. We remind you of some of the things to remember when sponsoring pilgrims.

Secondly, training is held before each set of walks for those who have said, "Yes!" to serving behind the scenes (**B.T.W**). This is a chance for you to meet with your team leader and begin to form a relationship with the others you will be serving with. Please understand that while exceptions can be made on a case by case basis, this **training is mandatory.** So, for all of you that have already agreed to serve at the upcoming walks in March, training is on March 1st from 8 - 12, at St Louis UMC. We will be worshiping with the conference room teams, sharing information needed for the walk weekend, and taking a tour of the church so we all know where everything is going to be. Food team members may want to bring a light sack lunch, as you will have a bit of additional training afterwards for about an hour.

# The following is the current Election Policy

#### **Election of Board Members**

- a. The Community elects all Lay Board Members
- b. The Assistant Community Lay Director (ACLD) shall serve as the Nominating Committee Chair
- c. The Nominating Committee shall make every effort to submit to the Board a slate of no less than 3 additional names over the required number to fill vacant board positions. (For example, if there are 4

vacant positions, 7 names should be submitted, if possible)

- d. The ballot shall be posted on the Lansing Area Emmaus Website no later than 10 days nor more than 60 days prior to the October gathering(s)/candlelight of each year. It will also be available at October gathering(s)/candlelight of each year.
- e. Ballots are to be received by the ACLD no later than at the October gathering of each year
- f. Absentee ballots may be delivered to any LAE Board Member prior to the October gathering
- g. Absentee ballots shall be delivered to the ACLD no later than at the October gathering

h. The Nominating Committee is responsible for counting and verifying the ballots, and then reporting the election results to the board at the November Board Meeting.
The Board will then vote to certify

the election. After Board certification of election results, The Assistant Community Lay Director (ACLD) shall contact all candidates. Elected Board Members will be invited to attend the December Board Meeting.

- i. The ACLD will retain the ballots in a secure location for six(6) months. The ballots shall be destroyed by June 1st
- j. Election is by majority or plurality vote of the ballots cast
- k. The immediate past Community Lay Director shall serve on the board one (1)

additional year or the normal period of the term whichever is longer

- Board members cannot be elected to consecutive three (3) year terms
- m. The Board may elect persons, upon nomination by the Community Lay Director, to fill a vacant term until the next regular election for that term. Such persons are eligible for election to a full term by the Community at such regular election. Persons elected to an unexpired three year term are eligible to be nominated for election to a full term, as they will not be in violation of Section 3d of Article IV of the Lansing Area Emmaus Community Bylaws.
- n. There shall be no write-in candidates on the ballot
