#### "I have never been asked"

#### "I wish you would stop calling"

My name is Jim Platt. I took walk #60 in 2005 at Clare, Michigan and at the table of Paul. When I was first asked to attend an Emmaus Walk, I had an excuse, but my sponsor did not give up on me, she asked me again. I now sit on the board of the Lansing Area Emmaus Community as chair for Facility and Site Selection.

The last three locations of our Emmaus Walks have been held at churches on the outer bounds of our community. This was an intentional effort to help serve a need to fill a gap with the Grand Rapids area. The Spring Walks are scheduled for March 1 - 4, 2018 (men), and March 15-18, 2018 (women). The board has agreed that these walks should be held in the Lansing area. At this time we do not have a location determined and if you belong to a church that could host these walks, I would like to hear from you. My phone number is (989) 289-9072 and my email is jimeplatt@gmail.com. Please help me with my position as Site Selection chair.

As Facilities Chair, my responsibility is to find a Facility Coordinator for each walk. This person is then responsible for the facility of the host church which this coming walk is Lakewood United Methodist Church in Lake Odessa. The Facility Coordinator selects teams that would include set-up, tear-down and housekeeping. These behind the scenes (BTS) positions are an agape gift to the pilgrims and are essential to the success of the Walk. In order for a person to work in the conference room, they must first



have worked 72 hours BTS. In order to lead a position such as set/up tear/down, housekeeping, kitchen or dining room, you must have some experience already working in that area. The conference room is first to make calls to fill their team and then the facility and food coordinators start calling people to lead their teams. This is when duplicate calls are unintentionally made, even before Team Leads have begun making their calls. This is when we hear "I wish you would stop calling".

On numerous occasions I have spoken with people who have told me they have "never been asked" to go on an Emmaus Walk. Likewise, I have been told by those who have been on a walk that they have "never been asked" to work BTS. I thank my Lord that my sponsor asked me multiple times to do both. If your sponsor has not called you and asked you to join them in working an Emmaus Walk BTS, please hear my plea. I am asking you; please make the effort to work an Emmaus BTS.
