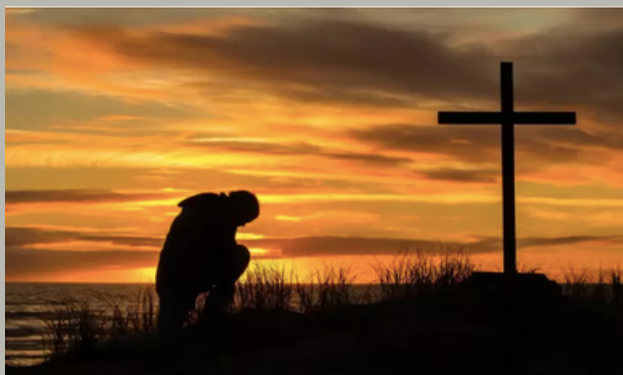


Footprints

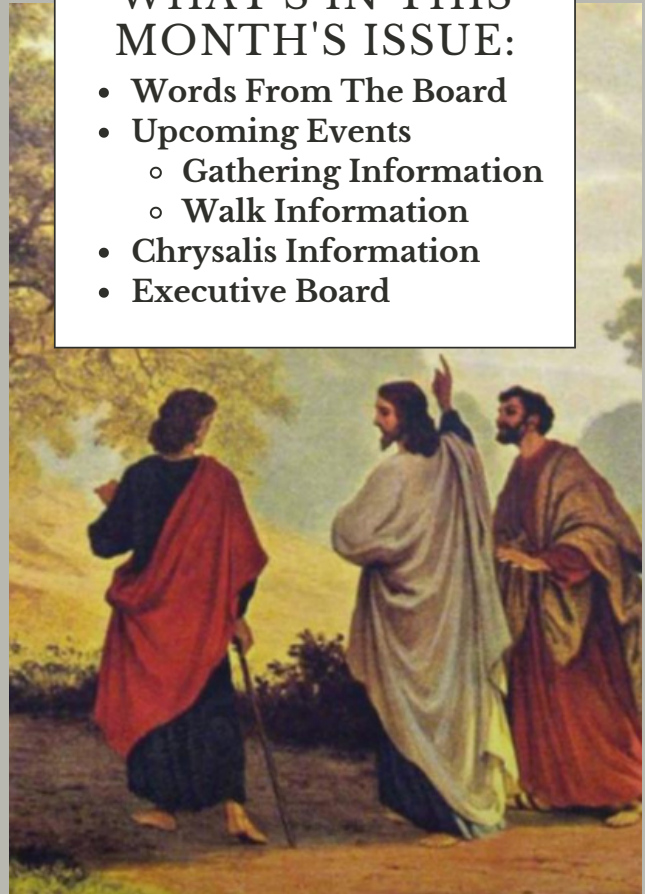
