Jeremiah 15:16

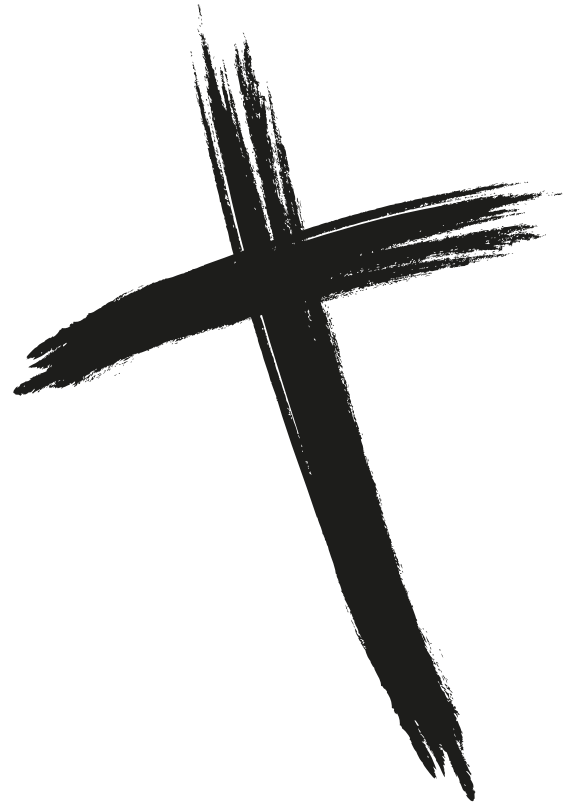
